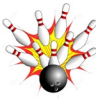

VINCENT C. SPINA MEMORIAL YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP RULES



1. ELIGIBILITY: *The event is open to all youth members of USBC regardless of their local association affiliation for the 2023-24 season.* USBC youth membership cards must be shown at check-in if requested.

2. AVERAGE: Entrants must use their highest league average, from their 2022-23 season or sport/challenge adjusted yearbook average (whichever is higher).

Bowlers without an established average will bowl with an average of 210.

Tournament Divisions:

Team:	Division 1: 600 and below Division 2: 601 and above
Doubles:	Division 1: 300 and below Division 2: 301 and above
Singles:	Division 1: 150 and below Division 2: 151 and above
All Events:	Division 1: 150 and below Division 2: 151 and above

3. TEAMS: All teams shall consist of four bowlers. Order of bowlers listed on entry forms will be the lineup utilized. Any USBC youth member who meets tournament rule #1 requirements is eligible to bowl as a substitute in the appropriate classification.

4. SQUADS: Squad assignments will be made as entries are received. Games will be bowled on the assigned pair of lanes. Bowler check-in is at least 1 hour before the scheduled starting squad time. Late arrivals will receive zero for the frames missed. There will be no practice between the Singles event and Doubles event.

WALK-IN ENTIRES IF AVAILABLE WILL CLOSE 45 MINUTES PRIOR TO EACH SQUAD'S SCHEDULED START TIME

5. HANDICAP: All handicaps will be based on 100% of the scores below for each event. There will be no negative handicap applied.

Team:	880 (3 games total handicap)
Doubles:	440 (3 games total handicap)
Singles:	220 (3 games total handicap)
All Events:	220 (9 games total handicap)

6. AWARDS: All financial awards will be in the form of scholarships. All prize fees collected will be returned 100%. Prize ratios for Singles, Doubles and Team Events is at least 1:4.

7. TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT: The tournaments will be conducted under the direction of the Tournament Director. The Tournament Director reserves the right to determine eligibility of and reclassify any entry at any time. Any protest must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director within 48 hours after the final squad starting time. The protest must be completed in writing and must comply with USBC tournament rules.

8. MULTIPLE ENTRIES: Bowlers may enter as often as they wish but may only win scholarships once per event with the same doubles partner and/or team. A team is considered different when one bowler has been substituted for a different bowler. **All Events will use the first 3 games bowled in Team, Singles and Doubles.** Bowlers may win Special Side Tournament awards in addition to winning the regular tournament prizes.

No re-entries for All Events.

9. BEHAVIOR: Participants will not be allowed to use tobacco products while bowling. Inappropriate language or other behavior is prohibited and will be grounds for disqualification. The Tournament Director's decision is final.

10. DRESS CODE: The Southeast PA USBC Tournament Dress Code will be strictly enforced. All apparel worn must not have holes, shirts must have sleeves and cover midriff. Bottom apparel must be at least longer than the fingertips when the arms of the bowler are hung straight down by the side when standing. Wearing of hat is not allowed. All undergarments must be covered. Clothing cannot have printing/advertising which promote tobacco, alcohol products or contain offensive language. Use of electronics in the settee area is not allowed.

11. SINGLES & DOUBLES EVENTS: During Singles & Doubles event, Singles will be bowled prior to Doubles. There will be no practice given between Singles and Doubles.

12. ENTRY CONFIRMATION: Southeast PA USBC's Tournament Director will make their best effort to send entry confirmation for entries received up to 14 days prior to the start of the tournament. WALK-IN ENTRIES ARE ON A FIRST COME/FIRST PAID BASIS. All Bowlers walking in must arrive no less than 45 minutes prior to the squad time and **pay \$5.00* per person per event.**
